### **State Certification of Human Trackers Proposed**

Denver, Colorado --- The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform (OPRRR) is currently conducting a sunrise review to determine if the General Assembly should regulate human trackers, who are individuals trained in the art of wilderness tracking. The application was filed January 22, 2008 by a Colorado citizen.

The sunrise application proposes that trackers be certified by the state. The application asserts that state certification is necessary so that local law enforcement agencies will use trackers to find lost individuals

The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform will submit its findings to the General Assembly by May 21, 2008. The review will include a recommendation on whether to regulate this profession.
