State Regulation of Interior Designers Requested

Denver, Colorado --- The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform (OPRRR) is currently conducting a sunrise review to determine if the General Assembly should create a new occupational license category for interior designers. Sunrise reviews examine whether new regulation is necessary to protect the public.

The Colorado Interior Design Coalition filed an application requesting certification conditioned upon the successful completion of a combination of education and experience totaling 6 years as well as the completion of an examination be required for Colorado interior designers.

The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform will submit its findings to the General Assembly by December 16, 2008. The review will include a recommendation on whether to regulate this profession.
