2010 Sunrise Review of Roofing Contractors Released

Denver, Colorado --- The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform has released a sunrise review examining the need for state regulation of roofing contractors. A sunrise review is required when any interested party proposes state regulation of a currently unregulated occupation or profession. Sunrise reviews determine whether the public is being harmed by the unregulated practice of an occupation or profession and whether there are less burdensome alternatives. These reviews are presented to the General Assembly to better enable it to evaluate the need for the regulation and to determine the least restrictive regulatory alternative consistent with the public interest.

A sunrise application was filed requesting certification and registration of roofing contractors. The 2010 sunrise review found that there is significant harm occurring to Colorado citizens from roofing contractors and has recommended that a registry be created and that examination, bonding and liability insurance requirements be implemented.
