State Regulation of Surgery Technicians Requested

Denver, Colorado --- The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform (OPRRR) is currently conducting a sunrise review to determine if the General Assembly should require regulation of surgery technicians. Sunrise reviews examine whether new regulation is necessary to protect the public.

Family Voices of Colorado filed an application requesting licensure or certification of surgery technicians, which would offer protection to the public from unqualified practitioners.

The Department of Regulatory Agencies' Office of Policy, Research and Regulatory Reform will submit its findings to the General Assembly by February 25, 2010. The review will include a recommendation on whether to regulate this profession.
