## E-UPDATE

### **COLORADO MASTER ELECTRICIANS, ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, HOMEOWNERS, AND LICENSEES**

#### **Fee Changes Effective September 1, 2010**

Beginning September 1, 2010, State Electrical permits for commercial and other valuation based permit fees will be issued under a new rate calculation.

For commercial and other valuation based permits, the base fee will be \$100 for projects worth \$2000 and under. The permit fee for all other projects will be 2.5% of the valuation plus \$100. The permit application process remains unchanged.



Residential fees based on square footage remain unchanged. License application fees to practice as an electrician are changing as follows and will be effective September 1, 2010:

Original License by Examination and Original License by Endorsement/Reciprocity:

- Master Electrician \$140
- Journeyman \$120
- Residential Wireman \$100

The fee to register as an electrical contractor has increased from \$30 to \$210.

The fee to register an apprentice has also increased from \$10 to \$30. We appreciate your diligence in submitting the correct amount with your apprentice registrations. Registrations submitted with less than the full \$30 fee payment will result in a delay since they will not be processed until the electrical contractor submits the full amount.

As an agency that is required to cover its expenditures with revenues, these fee increases are necessary due to recent and projected shortfalls in revenue.
