CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair, Leigh Ann McKenna.

MINUTES

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2006 meeting. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

OLD BUSINESS

The Office of Expedited Settlement provided Board members with their ESP Status Report for complaints registered with their office. Board members reviewed the progress of the listed complaints. No action necessary.

2004-003120 Respondent: Stoneleigh Barber AP 990041

Complainant: Stan Todd - Master Electric, Inc.

In compliance with the terms of his stipulated agreement Stoneleigh Barber provided his second quarterly report to update the Board. After review, a motion was made to accept Mr. Barber's report. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2005-002123 Respondent: Alan M. Lautrup JW 108006

Complainant: Colorado State Electrical Board

Board reviewed the second quarterly report from Alan M. Lautrup. After consideration and noting that Mr. Lautrup's report was submitted covering only the final quarter of 2005, a motion was made to require his next report to include the first and second quarter of 2006. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried. A second motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to accept the submitted report.

2005-003698 Respondent: Chadrick Nash AP 992425

Complainant: State Electrical Board

According to the terms of Chadrick Nash's stipulated agreement, he provided his 4th quarterly report. After discussion, a motion was made to accept Mr. Nash's report. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2006-002564 Respondent: Trevor Parmenter - Southpaw Electric ME 26795 EC 6295

Complainant: State Electrical Board

Steve Atkins, Electrical Inspector for the City of Longmont responded to the Board's request to investigate alleged contracting violations by Southpaw Electric. After reviewing Mr. Atkins response and noting that Southpaw Electric is in compliance with statutory requirements, a motion was made to dismiss the complaint. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

3901000100 & 3901000090 Respondent: Adam H. Hogue AP 960328

Complainant: Steve Hofmann - Zigniew Okanski

The Board reviewed the Administrative Law Judge's Initial Decision in the matter of disciplinary action against the electrical apprentice registration of Adam H. Hogue. After discussion, a motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve items 1 through 17 under "Findings of Fact". A second motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve items 1 through 16 under "Conclusions of Law". A final motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve the "Initial Decision". The Final Agency Order to revoke Adam H. Hogue's apprentice registration will be implemented through the Attorney General's Office.

OLD BUSINESS (continued)

The Board's decision at the January 8, 2006 meeting was to require one-year successful completion of probation before allowing JNO to take the electrical examination. After considering JNO's probation officers report and noting that he has not successfully completed one-year probation, a motion was made to table action pending updated information from JNO's probation officer. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Variance request Project: Grana residence Permit #581394

Arthur and Anita Grana submitted a variance request for the Board's review regarding the location of their solar equipment. After consideration, a motion was made to deny their request. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

COMPLAINTS

2006-002838 Respondent: Merlin Broughton - Broughton Electric ME 25256 EC 458

Complainant: Albert Parry, Pitkin County Electrical Inspector

The Board reviewed a complaint filed by Albert Parry, Pitkin County Electrical Inspector alleging that Broughton Electric failed to obtain a permit and allowed unlicensed and unsupervised employees to provide electrical service to a mobile home. Merlin Broughton failed to respond to the Board's request for information related to the allegations. Discussion then led to a motion to refer the complaint to the Office of Investigations. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2006-003333 Respondent: Brandon Walters - Electrical Outfitters RW 76960

Complainant: Joseph Brice - J.E.B. Electric Inc.

The Board considered complaint 2006-003333 filed by Joseph Brice of J.E.B. Electric Inc. alleging that Brandon Walters of Electrical Outfitters fraudulently obtained an electrical permit. After noting that Brandon Walters failed to respond as requested by the Board, a motion was made to forward the complaint to the Office of Investigations. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2006-003570 Respondent: William Collins - CRS Electric Services ME 27559 EC 6215

Complainant: Travis Marque

The Board reviewed correspondence received from respondent Williams Collins dated March 21, 2006. Travis Marque filed the complaint alleging that William Collins, master electrician of CRS Electrical Services is performing electrical wiring without permits. After considering both the response and complaint, a motion was made to refer the complaint to the Office of Investigations. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2006-003682 Respondent: Howard Snyder Unlicensed

Complainant: Jeff Switzer

Howard Snyder responded to the Board's inquiry regarding a complaint filed by Jeff Switzer alleging that Mr. Snyder performed electrical services without proper licensure. After reviewing both the complaint and Mr. Snyder's response, a motion was made to refer the complaint for discipline. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

2006-003864 Respondent: Steve Harris - Braggs Electric Construction ME 3793 EC 3116

Complainant: Richard Ramirez

The Board discussed respondent Steve Harris' response dated April 13, 2006 and the complaint filed by Richard Ramirez. Mr. Ramirez alleges that Braggs Electric Construction failed to obtain a permit and provide apprentice supervision. After consideration, a motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to dismiss the complaint.

APPLICATIONS

The Board considered GDL's electrical application for reciprocity as a journeyman electrician. Discussion resulted in a motion to approve GDL for reciprocity. According to the report from the district court, disciplinary action was successfully completed. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board discussed GRP's application for the journeyman examination. After considering the provided documentation of wiring experience, a motion was made to deny GRP for examination. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board reviewed JJR's request for reinstatement of his journeyman license that expired February 28, 2003. After consideration and noting that JJR will not complete probation until December 22, 2010, a motion was made to deny reinstatement. Examination will be required after providing documentation of successful completion of one year of probation. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board gave consideration to PLG's journeyman application concerning his request for military time to be credited toward his overall experience for examination and licensure. After reviewing the military documentation provided, a motion was made to approve PLG's application for examination. The motion was seconded and carried.

DBP's master electrician's application that included a letter from an electrical inspector from the City of Mobile was presented before the Board. After review, a motion was made to deny DPB for examination. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The journeyman application and court documents for JWL were reviewed by the Board. After consideration and noting that one year of probation has not been completed, a motion was made to deny JWL's application. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

SAM appeared before the Board to present his application for the journeyman license that includes foreign electrical experience. After an interview and noting SAM's verification of wiring experience in Colorado did not require supervision, a motion was made to deny for examination. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board discussed CRC's application for the residential examination. After considering the provided court documentation and noting disciplinary action was completed April 6, 2005, a motion was made to allow entrance into the examination process. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board interviewed ATB to consider his foreign electrical experience along with his application for the journeyman license. After discussion and noting verification of wiring experience in Colorado, a motion was made to approve ATB for the journeyman examination. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

In response to the Board's inquiry, the felony conviction record for EGB was reviewed. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to dismiss.

OTHER BUSINESS

Program Director Gary Fugate reported that DORA Investigator David Sexton contacted him regarding Ron Barbour's request to discuss matters concerning his revoked license. Mr. Barbour will be scheduled to attend the June electrical board meeting.

Board members were reminded to consider nominations for Board positions for fiscal year 2007. Nominations will be made at the June meeting with the actual vote during July 10, 2006 meeting.

With all business being completed, the meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 12, 2006 at 9:30 a.m.
