The meeting of the Board was publicly noticed according to the Division of Registrations' Policy 80-17.

3 year renewal cycle discussion –

Following the discussion at the 9/28/09 CC work group a proposal was made to change the renewal cycle to three years. This proposal was made for the following reasons:

- To better coincide with the National Electrical Code revisions, which are on a three year cycle.
- Require the licensees to keep current on Code changes due to the cycling and timing change.
- To allow for a better acceptance by the industry due to:
 - Inclusion of the PDU requirements (if the assessment determines areas which require improvement)
 - Additional time for the individual licensees to achieve their required PDU credits.

It is the belief of the workgroup that the change to a three year cycle would be of greater benefit to the industry and facilitate compliance with the requirements which were enacted by the Governor and the State Legislature.

The **COLORADO STATE ELECTRICAL BOARD, CONTINUING COMPETENCY WORKGROUP** draft rules were developed and are now passed to respective individual departments within DORA's Department of Registrations for review before being presented to the full Board for review.

The business of the workgroup being completed, no further meeting are scheduled.
