WORK EXPERIENCE DEFINITIONS

RESIDENTIAL

Includes new construction, remodeling and additions to buildings for residential occupancy (one, two, three, and four-unit family dwellings). Also include apartment buildings, condominiums, and townhouses. Work done within all residential units will receive residential credit. Work done in common areas such as laundry rooms, corridors, rec. rooms, etc. will receive commercial credit. **DO NOT** include mobile park service facilities.

COMMERCIAL

Includes new construction remodeling and additions to stores, office buildings, gas stations, theaters, mobile home park supply, irrigation pumps, warehouses, hospitals, and other buildings and facilities of a similar nature.

INDUSTRIAL

Includes remodeling, additions and new construction of manufacturing plants of all types.

MAINTENANCE

Includes all time spent in repairing, replacing and taking care of existing electrical facilities.

PLANNING AND LAYOUT OF ELECTRICAL WORK

Includes the time that you have spent in actually planning and laying out the installation of wiring apparatus, or equipment for electrical light, heat and power.
