INSTRUCTIONS NAME CHANGE FOR PRENEED FUNERAL/BURIAL CONTRACT SELLERS

The sale of contracts that provide for funeral, entombment or cremation goods or services in the future is governed by Title 10, Article 15 of Colorado Revised. A firm desiring to engage in this type of preneed sale must have a license in the new name from the Division of Insurance.

The following items must be filed and approved by the Division of Insurance before a license in the new name will be issued:

1. License application. No fee is required.
2. Certificate of Good Standing issued by the Colorado Secretary of State for all corporations and partnerships.
 - For all entities using a d/b/a in Colorado it will be necessary to submit evidence of filing and acceptance by the Colorado Secretary of State.
 - NOTE: Certificates of Authority issued will reflect the company's name exactly the same as on file with the Secretary of State.
3. Surrender of the original Certificate of Authority previously issued by this Division.
4. A description of the method to be used to notify existing preneed contract holders of the new name. (For example, a copy of the notification letter or the contract endorsement.)
