Provide the following information:

- Plan of Dissolution. Must include detailed information on the transfer of any insurance risks along with the status of other outstanding liabilities.
- Three (3) originally executed copies of the Articles of Dissolution along with a copy of the shareholders/board of directors' resolution adopting the Articles, certified by the Company's secretary. After approval by this Division, these are required to be filed with the Colorado Secretary of State. A copy of the Articles, certified by the Secretary of State will then have to be filed with this Division.
- Final annual statement taxes & fees paid.
- Return the original Certificate of Authority previously issued to the Company by this Division.
- Arrange for the release of the statutory deposit.
