Once a demutualization of an insurance company has been approved by the policyholders and the Company's state of domicile, the following items are to be filed with this Division:

- One copy of the amended articles of incorporation, certified by the company's state of domicile.
- One current Certificate of Compliance issued by the company's state of domicile.
- Plan of conversion, along with evidence of approval of the conversion from the domiciliary insurance department.
- If the demutualization includes a name change, information required by the NAIC UCAA Corporate Amendments process must also be provided.
