The meeting was called to order by Chair Hart Axley. Minutes of the September 16, 2009, were approved as distributed.

Cindy Ward reported on the DOI sponsored Ethics class held October 20, 2009. The class was evenly split between life and p/c producers. Few participants reported membership in an association primarily due to the cost.

LTC Regulation 4-4-4 will not be changed which disallows 'step down' inflation due to age. The issue may be revisited in the future. The DOI will research the issue among the States.

Cameron Lewis reported that she is working on a consumer check list on questions to be asked in the purchase of individual health insurance, auto insurance, and homeowners insurance. Calls are received with questions by the media.

Jo Donlin reported on continuing out reach and the efforts to distribute brochures to consumers. The new brochure on Discount Health Plans was distributed to the Council.

Eight bills have been recommended by the Health Care Task Force. These include: no gender rating in individual health insurance, standardized health insurance policies and EOB's, provider fee schedule for Cover Colorado, maternity requirement in the individual market.

The final report concerning Pinocle is scheduled for November 4, 2009. It will call for a balance of surplus to reserves.

Carol O'Bryan gave an overview on market conduct section. This is the non-financial section relating to how carriers are behaving in the market place. The NAIC publishes a handbook on standards annually.

The meeting adjourned. The next regularly scheduled will be November 18, 2009.
