Health Reimbursement Arrangements and Small Group Health Plans

I. Background and Purpose

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide guidance to health carriers, insurance producers, employers with 50 or fewer employees, and employees of such employers, of the application of §10-16-105.2(1), C.R.S. requiring that health benefit plans purchased utilizing a health reimbursement arrangement (HRA) are subject to the provisions of Article 16 including the requirements of §10-16-105, C.R.S.

Bulletins are the Colorado Division of Insurance's (Division) interpretations of existing insurance law or general statements of Division policy. Bulletins themselves establish neither binding norms nor finally determine issues or rights.

Notice: On November 16, 2010, former Commissioner Marcy Morrison issued a decision and Final Agency Order in a proceeding "In the Matter of the Petition for Declaratory Judgment and Order of CoverColorado."

As Section 4 of the Order conflicts with some of the interpretations in Bulletin B-4.32 on Health Reimbursement Arrangements and Small Group Health Plans, Bulletin B-4.32 is hereby withdrawn.
