## **Bulletin No. B-4.40**

### **Concerning the Minimum Mammography Benefit**

#### **I. Background and Purpose**

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide carriers with the minimum benefit amount for mammograms effective January 1, 2012.

Bulletins are the Division's interpretations of existing insurance law or general statements of Division policy. Bulletins themselves establish neither binding norms nor finally determine issues or rights.

#### **II. Applicability and Scope**

This bulletin is intended for all group and individual sickness and accident insurance policies and all service or indemnity contracts issued by licensed carriers, including health maintenance organizations, licensed in the state of Colorado.

#### **III. Division Position**

Section 10-16-104(18)(b)(III)(B), C.R.S., specifies that the minimum benefit amount will be adjusted based on the consumer price index (CPI). The minimum benefit amount was not changed January 2011 due to the de minimus change in the CPI from fiscal year 2008-2009 to fiscal year 2009-2010. Therefore, the change effective January 1, 2012 incorporates the change in the CPI from fiscal year 2008-2009 to fiscal year 2010-2011. The minimum benefit effective January 1, 2012 is \$103.50.
