

MEDICAID DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Copies of the following documents are required when making a Medicaid application. **If there is spouse, copies are required of his/her documents as well.**

___ Original Birth or Baptismal Certificate (Immigration papers or passport are acceptable)
Documentation showing proof of U.S. citizenship is mandatory)

___ Marriage License (if spouse is still alive)

___ Veteran's Discharge Papers

___ Social Security Card

___ Medicare Card

___ Colorado ID card or driver's license **Photo ID mandatory**

___ Supplemental Insurance Card

___ Automobile registration or car title

___ Checking Account Statements for the last 6 months

___ Savings Account statements for the last 6 months (also CD, Credit Union, etc.)

___ Statements from stocks, IRAs, Annuities, 401Ks, etc., for last 6 months

___ Social Security Income Benefit Statement (Social Security 1-800-772-1213)

___ Pension Income Statement (includes VA pension) (Need gross payment amount)

___ Life Insurance Policy(ies) - need to get letter from the company stating Face Value and current Cash Value

___ Funeral / Burial Insurance Policy(ies)

___ Deed to home and/or any other property owned or documentation from sale

___ Property Tax statement (for all property owned)

___ Rent receipt or mortgage payment

___ Durable Power of Attorney

If there is a spouse the following bills or statements are also required:
