Comments on Placements from ADN programs:

- 80% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing pediatric placements
- 50% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing OB placements
- 35% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing Psychiatric placements
- 15% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing capstone placements
- 10% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing med surge placements
- 5% of the AD N programs have most difficulty securing critical care placements

Issues identified by ADN programs:

- Hospital magnet status promotes interest in BSN students
- Platform is not always dependable as a program can be bumped out
- Hospitals placing limits on #'s of students
