Comments on Placements from BSN programs:

- 80% of the BSN programs found pediatric placements to be most difficult to secure
- 60% of the BSN programs found psychiatric placements to be the most difficult to secure
- 30% of the BSN programs found obstetric placements to be the most difficult to secure
- 20% of the BSN programs found senior practicum placements to be the most difficult to secure
- 10% of the BSN programs found critical care placements to be the most difficult to secure
- 10% of the BSN programs found community health placements to be the most difficult to secure

Issues identified by BSN programs:

- Platform is more democratic but has reduced relationship building and previously held placements are now lost
- Some hospitals do not accept ACCSCT accredited schools
- One school was being charged for access to the particular placement in addition to the charge for the clinical scholars
