Dear Members of the General Assembly:

The Colorado Telemedicine Pilot Program for Chronic Conditions (Program) created under Article 5 of Title 25.5, Colorado Revised Statutes, is scheduled to sunset on July 1, 2010. Prior to this time, the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) is charged with conducting a sunset review and providing recommendations to the General Assembly regarding whether or not the Program should continue or be allowed to sunset.

On August 16, 2009, funding for the Program was terminated pursuant to Executive Order D 017 09. Accordingly, DORA recommends that the General Assembly repeal the statutory provisions creating the Program.
