**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On July 10, 2003, Premier Senior Services, filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle under permit number B-9850.
2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on July 14, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on September 17, 2003.
3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is non-contested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested suspension.
5. The application for authority to suspend contract carrier permit number B-9850 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for September 17, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete August 21, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Premier Senior Services for authority to suspend operations under contract carrier permit number B-9850 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under contract carrier permit number B-9850 is authorized from July 2, 2003 through January 2, 2004.
5. On or before December 2, 2003, Premier Senior Services shall file a written request either to reinstate contract carrier permit number B-9850 or to extend the suspension period.
6. Prior to reinstatement, Premier Senior Services shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Premier Senior Services shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate contract carrier permit number B-9850 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the permit without further notice.

8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.

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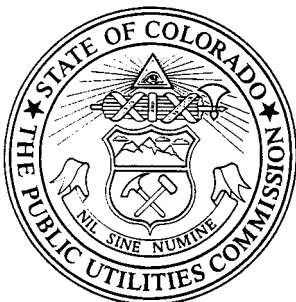
