**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On March 25, 2004, Anlance Protection, Ltd. filed an application to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55678, and Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9813.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on April 5, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on June 9, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested abandonment.

5. The application to abandon CPCN PUC No. 55678 and Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9813 is in the public interest.

**II. ORDER**

**A. The Commission Orders That**

1. The hearing set for June 9, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on June 2, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Anlance Protection, Ltd. for approval to abandon operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55678, and Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9813 is granted.
4. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55678, and Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9813 are CANCELED.
5. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

6. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
