STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

2. The evidence submitted warrants approval of the transfer of the capital stock, as requested.

3. The Transferee is fit, willing, and able to perform the

operations required by Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 15356&I. The transfer is compatible with the public interest.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Patricia L. Marez is authorized to transfer 5000 shares of the issued and outstanding capital stock of Al's Hot Oil Service, Inc., record owner of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 15356&I to the corporation and thereby transfer control to Alfred R. Marez.

2. The right of Transferee to operate under this Order shall depend on compliance with the present and future laws and Commission rules and regulations, and the prior filing by Transferor of delinquent reports, if any, covering operations under the Certificate up to the time of the Transfer of the capital stock.

3. The right of Transferee to operate under this Order shall depend on its compliance with all present and future laws and Commission rules and regulations and the prior filing by Transferor of delinquent reports, if any, covering operations under the Certificate up to the time of transfer.

4. Transferee shall file an acceptance of stock transfer signed by the buyers and sellers. Operations may not begin until these requirements have been met. If the Applicants do not comply with the requirements of this ordering paragraph within 60 days of the effective date of this Order then ordering paragraph 1 above, which grants authority to the Transferee, shall be void, and the authority granted shall then be void. On good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
