STATEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 15, 1994, an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") for the Commission issued Decision No. R94-269, recommending adoption of certain rules. Pursuant to § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S. (1993), the Recommended Decision shall become the decision of the Commission if no exceptions are filed within 20 days after service of the ALJ's order. Section 40-6-109(2), however, permits the Commission to stay the Recommended Decision upon its own motion.

The Commission will stay Decision No. R94-269 on its own motion in order to allow for Commission review of the rules recommended by the ALJ. At a future Open Meeting, the Commission shall review the ALJ's recommendation along with any exceptions filed within 20 days after Decision No. R94-269 was mailed.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:


In accordance with the provisions of § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S. (1993), Decision No. R94-269, mailed March 15, 1994, is hereby stayed.
