PRINCIPAL PROPOSED CHANGES

The intrastate access changes contained in these tariff revisions are in order to comply with the Rules Prescribing the Standard Procedures for Separating the Property Costs, Revenues, Expenses, Taxes, and Reserves for Access Charges of Rural Telecommunications Providers (4 CCR 723-27-Part 2). This filing will increase the Company's composite intrastate access rate by approximately 34%.

Concurrent with these tariff changes, the Company is requesting to establish support from the Colorado High Cost Fund under the Rules Prescribing the Procedures for Administering the Colorado High Cost Fund (4 CCR 723-41). The Company qualifies for \$21,015 of support for High Cost Loops (Rule 18.1) and \$1,372 of support for High Exchange Trunk Costs (Rule 18.3). Accordingly, the Company seeks support in the amount of \$22,387 from the Colorado High Cost Support Mechanism.

EFFECT ON UTILITY REVENUES

As a result of this filing, it is anticipated that the Company's revenues will increase by \$92,722. This is comprised of an increase in access revenues of \$70,335 and the proposed increase in Colorado High Cost support of \$22,387.

EFFECT ON CUSTOMERS

The rates charged to interexchange carriers will change as a result of this filing. The Company's interexchange customers are being notified of the proposed changes. A certificate of notification will be sent under separate cover.
