### **STIPULATION**

Tazco, Inc. d/b/a Sunshine Taxi (Sunshine Taxi), Complainant and Counter-Respondent, on the one hand, and named Respondents and Counter-Complainants , Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie Segers, individually and/or d/b/a Star Taxi and/or Designated Drivers (the Segers), submit their settlement stipulation in Docket No. 03F-164CP, stating as follows to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC or Commission):

- Sunshine Taxi, on the one hand, and the Segers, on the other hand, also attach a 1. copy of the transcript of the July 17, 2003 terms of the settlement for reference. See Exhibit 3 attached.
- The Segers agree they do not presently hold authority from the PUC either 2. individually or as a partnership or as any other association or entity.
- Darrel G. Segers stipulates and agrees that he has settled the civil penalty 3. assessment that was issued against him in Docket No. 03G-136CP by the PUC, by the terms of a document that was filed with the Commission on July 16, 2003, and a copy of which is attached

hereto as Exhibit 1. The document was not filed under seal and is public record.

- 4. The Segers further stipulate and agree that Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie Segers, individually and d/b/a Star Taxi and/or d/b/a Designated Drivers will immediately cease and desist from operating a for-hire transportation service without appropriate PUC authority or approval.
- 5. The Segers recognize and agree that the nonprofit voluntary donation, tip transportation that they individually or collectively, either as Designated Drivers or otherwise, were providing in the past is unlawful and unauthorized and would require PUC authority. They admit that the trips conducted as Designated Drivers as shown in the spreadsheet attached to discovery responses the Segers filed are unlawful and are trips that would require specific PUC authority to perform. A copy of the discovery responses is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
- 6. The Segers and Sunshine Taxi also agree that at the time the trips shown on Exhibits 1 and 2 were conducted the Segers believed that they did not require PUC authority to perform the trips shown on Exhibits 1 and 2.
- 7. The Segers individually and/or d/b/a Star Taxi and/or Designated Drivers and/or as part of any other entity will not in the future undertake or perform, or in any way become involved in any nonprofit, volunteer tip, or donation type operation unless and until they receive authority from the PUC that authorizes them to perform such service.
- 8. The Segers, individually and doing business as Star Taxi and/or Designated Drivers or as part of any other entity, agree that the tip/voluntary nonprofit/donation operation previously conducted by them requires authority from the PUC. The Segers further advise Sunshine Taxi and the PUC that all types of such operations are not being conducted as of July 17, 2003.

- 9. The Segers further agree that they will not conduct operations in the future individually or as part of a partnership, association, or nonprofit corporation or any other entity without appropriate authority from the PUC to do so.
- 10. The Segers further stipulate and agree and understand that if they violate any portion of the stipulation, they recognize that Sunshine Taxi reserves all rights and claims against them including the right to initiate court action for injunctive relief and/or damages, including, but not limited to any such claims relating to the trips shown on Exhibits 1 and 2 attached.
- 11. If this stipulation is approved, Sunshine Taxi dismisses its complaint against the Segers. In return, the Segers dismiss their amended counter-complaint against Sunshine Taxi; both dismissals being with prejudice except to the extent that Sunshine Taxi reserves its rights and claims against the Segers if this stipulation is violated.
- 12. The parties further agree that Sunshine Taxi reserves any and all rights to oppose any future PUC applications of any type Darrel G. Segers and/or Terry Marie Segers may make, individually or as part of any other entity, in which they seek PUC authority or authorization to conduct any service in any geographic area that duplicates Sunshine Taxi's authority.
- Administrative Law Judge that, in addition to whatever rights Sunshine Taxi may reserve, any violation of the stipulation would also violate an order of the PUC and the Commission could then go to court to seek an injunction to enforce its order and/or the Segers may be subject to civil penalties. The Segers also acknowledge they were informed by the Administrative Law Judge that by dismissing the counter-complaint with prejudice, they will not be able to bring the

counter-complaint or bring a complaint based on those same allegations covering the same time period in the future.

- 14. The Segers further recognize and agree that they have been specifically informed by the Administrative Law Judge that they agree, among other things, not to do or conduct any donation based transportation operation either in their own names or in association with anyone else, without PUC authorization.
- 15. The parties further agree that the pertinent parts of the transcript of proceedings on July 17, 2003 relative to the terms of this stipulation are included as part of the transcript attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

### STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado (Staff) and Darrel G. Segers d/b/a Star Taxi & Associates, a/k/a Designated Drivers (Respondent) (Staff and Respondent shall be referred to collectively as Parties), enter into this Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Stipulation) to stipulate and settle all disputed issues arising out of Civil Penalty Assessment Notice No. 28066 (CPAN No. 28066). Staff and Respondent respectfully submit that this Stipulation is just and reasonable. The Parties believe that this Stipulation is justified on its face and, therefore, the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) should approve it without hearing.

Darrel G. Segers, acting pro se, states that he has the authority to execute this Stipulation on behalf of Respondent. Staff states that the undersigned member of Staff has the authority to execute this Stipulation on behalf of Staff.

### I BACKGROUND

- 1. On March 27, 2003 Staff issued CPAN No. 28066 to Respondent. A copy of CPAN No. 28066 is attached to this Stipulation as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein by reference. CPAN No. 28066 cites Respondent for five (5) violations of § 40-10-104(1), C.R.S., which provides in pertinent part: "No motor vehicle carrier shall operate any motor vehicle for the transportation of persons upon the public highways of this state in intrastate commerce without first having obtained from the Commission a certificate declaring that the present or future public convenience and necessity requires or will require such operation."
- 2. The alleged violations occurred on February 15, 2003; February 19, 2003; February 27, 2003; February 28, 2003; and March 23, 2003. Commission Rule 4 CCR 723-31-40.4.1 allows for a penalty of up to four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per violation of C.R.S. § 40-10-104(1). Staff sought the maximum penalty in this Docket for five (5) violations, or two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).
- 3. Respondent admits that on each of the dates appearing on CPAN No. 28066, Respondent operated a motor vehicle for the transportation of persons upon the public roads of Colorado in intrastate commerce without first obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) or any other authority from the Commission.
- 4. On March 5, 2003 Respondent filed its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate as a Common Carrier by Motor Vehicle for Hire (Application) pursuant to C.R.S. § 40-10-104(1). The Commission assigned Docket No. 03A-108CP to Respondent's Application and set it for hearing on July 15-16, 2003.

### II. STIPULATION

- 5. The Parties agree that this Stipulation resolves all of the issues that were or could have been raised in this matter. In general terms, Staff is accepting reduced payment in satisfaction of the assessed civil penalty in response to measures undertaken by Respondent to ensure compliance with the requirement of having obtained a CPCN from the Commission prior to operating a motor vehicle for the transportation of persons upon the public roads of Colorado in intrastate commerce.
- 6. Staff is willing to accept a reduced payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the civil penalty assessed by CPAN No. 28066.
- 7. Staff's acceptance of a reduced penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) is appropriate in light of the measures undertaken by Respondent to ensure future compliance with the requirement of § 40-10-104(1), C.R.S.
- 8. Respondent shall remit to the Commission the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in satisfaction of CPAN No. 28066. Respondent shall remit the one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in not more than four (4) equal monthly payments of at least two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) each, to be paid as follows:
  - a. The first payment shall be due and payable ten (10) days after the final Commission decision in this Docket.
  - b. The second payment shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after the date of the first payment.
  - c. The third payment shall be due and payable sixty (60) days after the date of the first payment.

- d. The fourth and final payment shall be due and payable ninety (90) days after the date of the first payment.
  - e. Respondent may prepay any amount of the total without penalty.
- 9. Respondent agrees that if Respondent fails to comply with the provisions of Paragraph 8 of this Stipulation, then (a) the admission of liability as stated above shall be conclusive evidence that the violation occurred and that the fine assessed is justified, and (b) the full \$2,000.00 penalty assessed by CPAN No. 28066 shall immediately be due and payable.

### **III. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- 10. The Parties agree that this Stipulation should be approved in its entirety.
- 11. The Parties agree that reaching this agreement by means of negotiation and settlement rather than through litigation is in the public interest and that the results of the compromises and settlements reflected in this Stipulation are in the public interest. The Parties further agree that all matters that were raised or could have been raised in this Docket have been resolved by this Stipulation. This resolution depends upon Respondent fully complying the terms set forth in Section II above.
- 12. This Stipulation has been entered into between the Parties solely for the purpose of settlement and resolution of the issues in this Docket. Therefore, the issues and matters resolved by this Stipulation apply only to this Docket and the issues raised in this Docket. Except as otherwise provided, the Parties reserve the right in the future to advocate

positions different from those stated in this Stipulation. Nothing in this Stipulation shall constitute a waiver by any party with respect to any matter not specifically addressed.

- 13. If the Commission does not approve this Stipulation in its entirety, this Stipulation shall be null and void. If the Commission imposes conditions or modifications to its approval of this Stipulation which are unacceptable to a party, such party shall notify the other party within five (5) days after the date the Commission's decision becomes final, which shall be effective notice to render this Stipulation null and void. In that event, this matter shall be set for hearing.
- 14. The Stipulation may be executed in counterparts and by facsimile copies of signatures, all of which when taken together shall constitute the entire Stipulation.

## RESPONSE TO LATEST REQUEST FOR INTERROGATORIES

### PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

D/B/A as Star taxi has not operated one day nor to the best of our knowledge for one single run. Star Taxi exists in name only, dependent on permit application approval.

The association of owner operators has not operated one single day. The association of owner operators existed in name only, dependent on permit application approval.

The association of owner operators no longer exists, Leslie G Cardin was dismissed as a volunteer with designated drivers& resigned, both Daniel J Mcguire and Kerrie A Foster have quit or resigned.

Designated driver / Safe Ride programs are promoted by both national & U.S.Government agencies, Communities & individuals are encouraged to start up & operate nonprofit designated driver / safe ride programs, We do have our application in for non profit status. Law enforcement agencies support Designated Driver / safe ride programs /services.

Designated driver / safe ride programs vary according to community demand & needs, volunteer designated drivers provide safe rides for those who are impaired or would other wise ride with some one who is impaired. Recommended operational procedures are the use of cell phones to keep in touch with drivers for there safety as well as inform them of requests for rides. Volunteer drivers accept donations / tips for the service that they provide. Volunteer drivers tip the phone people as is standard practice in any & all service industry businesses to share your tips. When volunteer drivers are not on call they locate at one of the local drinking establishment, in this way they are readily available when some one needs a ride & reduces the temptation to drive impaired or ride with some one who is impaired. Designated Driver Services / safe ride programs are supported by grants / donations made to the office of designated driver services by local establishments that designated driver /safe rides provides services for. Volunteer drivers do not pay designated driver services. It is recommended that designated driver/ safe ride volunteers do not make judgement calls as to wether or not any individuals are or are not impaired or that they will or will not ride with some one who is impaired.

Tazco INC D/B/A Sunshine taxi in effect is asking that Designated Driver Services / Safe Ride programs be banned as illegal public services in the state of Colorado .

Designated Driver / Safe Ride programs reduces D.U.Is. & D.W.Is. and saves lives.

(NOTE) For once we were not insulted for starting up a nationally & us government promoted public service, thank you, we will attempt to provide what you request however we do not have all the data that you request.

- I. (1) See attached monthly sheets.
- (2) We don't have this Data, we don't keep track of how many are in a party, often the drivers receive donations at the beginning of the evening & then provide transportation threw out the evening.
- (3) Phone people stay in touch with volunteer drivers for there safety as well as when requests come in for rides, no money is paid to designated driver services, there is no revenue sharing agreement other than volunteer drivers are expected to share there tips with the phone people.
- (4) when calls come into the office designated drivers volunteer phone people take the call if it is a request for a ride they call volunteer drivers on duty & ask if they want to take the call all volunteer drivers may refuse any request, often volunteer drivers will be on location & get a request they then inform phone people that they have riders or requested transportation & that they are unavailable to take requests or calls.
- (5) we do not keep this kind of data, we use names & streets or bar locations. As previously stated often we receive one donation then provide 2 or more trips
- (6) (7) (8) (9) (10) Designate Driver Services has received no funds From any establishment Nor to the best of our knowledge has any drivers designated drivers has turned down offers of donations because of the impending legal issues.
- II. (1) (2)(3) We have no contracts or agreements with any body
- (4) I / WE do not keep accurate records, as a non regulated public service we are not required to keep any records, we do provide trip sheets to the volunteer drivers who may wish to use them. We do not keep copies of these trip sheets please explain the importance of this data as well as why is your client sunshine taxi continuing to referring people to us who have little or no ability to pay we feel that do to amount of work & time as well as paper work involved to prepare this paper work for record as we have not been keeping up with such documentation is nothing more than aggravation tactics.

- 4 Mr. and Mrs. Segers further stipulate and
- 5 agree and understand that if they violate any portion
- 6 of the stipulation, they recognize that Sunshine Taxi
- 7 reserves all rights and claims against them including
- 8 the right to initiate court action for injunctive
- 9 relief and/or damages.
- 10 If that stipulation is approved with
- 11 respect to the Segers, Sunshine Taxi dismisses its
- 12 complaint against Mr. and Mrs. Segers. In return,
- 13 Mr. and Mrs. Segers dismiss their amended counter-
- 14 complaint against Sunshine Taxi; both dismissals being
- 15 with prejudice except to the extent that Sunshine Taxi
- 16 would reserve its rights and claims if the stipulation
- 17 was violated for the matters I earlier discussed.
- 18 Sunshine Taxi -- the parties further
- 19 agree that Sunshine Taxi reserves any and all rights to
- 20 oppose any future P.U.C. applications of any type

- 23 authorization to conduct any service in any geographic
- 24 area that duplicates Sunshine Taxi's authority.

- 3 to the Commission, Sunshine Taxi's complaint is

- 25 that took place with the Administrative Law Judge

- 1 attached to the settlement stipulation as a further
- 2 exhibit so that you can see that we're submitting --
- 3 what we're submitting is exactly what we agreed to.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay. Now that,
- 5 I think, renders moot the following pending motions. I
- 6 want to get this on the record just so we wrap up some
- 7 things. It renders moot -- that is to say the
- 8 Commission does not need to make a decision on -- this
- 9 will take some time these are lengthy titles on the
- 10 following motions: The Motion in Limine limiting
- 11 participation of Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie
- 12 Segers in this case and/or requiring counsel for other
- 13 entities including the entity known as Darrel G. Segers
- 14 and Terry Marie Segers doing business as Designated
- 15 Drivers, the request for shortened response time --
- 16 excuse me, that motion is moot as a result of this.
- 17 Tazco's motion for summary judgment in
- 18 its complaint against Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie
- 19 Segers is moot.
- The second -- Tazco's second motion to
- 21 strike the response of Darrel Segers to the complaint
- 22 and for various other relief is also rendered moot.
- 23 Tazco's motion for modification of
- 24 certain portions of Recommended Decision R03-0710-I.
- 25 And finally, the motion for leave to

- 1 amend the response to the amended counter-complaint is
- 2 also rendered moot.
- 3 There is a pending motion which is not
- 4 addressed by the settlement reached as between the
- 5 Segers and Tazco; but -- yes, Mr. Williams?
- 6 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, you're
- 7 absolutely correct. They are rendered moot; however on
- 8 Tazco's behalf -- Sunshine Taxi's behalf, they are
- 9 rendered moot contingent on acceptance of the
- 10 stipulation and agreement and -- however I don't
- 11 anticipate a problem in that regard -- in the event the
- 12 stipulation is rejected or not completed by -- rejected
- 13 by the Administrative Law Judge or not completed, then
- 14 we would reserve the right to reoffer those without
- 15 refiling.
- And Mr. and Mrs. Segers -- may I address
- 17 them, Your Honor?
- 18 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Actually, why

- May we go off the record for just a
- 18 minute. I need to speak with Ms. Cardin.
- 19 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: We'll take a five
- 20 minute recess.
- MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you.
- 22 (Recess.)
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: We'll be back on
- 24 the record.
- Mr. Williams, please address the motion

- 1 for entry of default.
- 2 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, with respect
- 3 to the motion for entry of default, I would like to
- 4 reserve for a moment my comments with respect to
- 5 Ms. Foster and Mr. McGuire and deal solely with
- 6 Ms. Cardin -- Ms. Leslie Cardin.
- 7 Ms. Cardin is present in the hearing room
- 8 and she and I have had discussions concerning her past
- 9 relationship with Designated Drivers; and, in fact, she
- 10 testified in the earlier case, the companion
- 11 application case Docket No. 03A-108CP.
- 12 Sunshine Taxi and Ms. Cardin have also
- 13 reached a tentative agreement with respect to
- 14 Sunshine's Taxi's claims against her, and they are as
- 15 follows: Ms. Cardin agrees that at one time she worked
- 16 or was associated with Designated Drivers as a driver.
- 17 And she also agrees that she, in approximately April of
- 18 2003, disassociated herself from Designated drivers and
- 19 is no longer associated with Designated Drivers. She
- 20 further agrees that she does not provided any
- 21 transportation for hire currently and will not in the
- 22 future without appropriate P.U.C. authority. By that I
- 23 mean a tip, donation type of service.
- 24 She does however recognize and Sunshine
- 25 Taxi agrees that if she wants to provide a truly free

- 1 service in other words, take a friend of hers home from
- 2 the bar with no compensation being paid, that she can
- 3 do that.
- 4 Ms. Cardin also advises that she works as
- 5 a school bus driver and Sunshine Taxi agrees with her
- 6 that that does not require P.U.C. authority and the
- 7 terms of the stipulation do not reach that activity.
- 8 That is the terms of the settlement that
- 9 Sunshine Taxi has with Ms. Cardin. The terms of that
- 10 settlement are agreeable to Sunshine Taxi; and if
- 11 Ms. Cardin agrees to those terms and if the terms are
- 12 acceptable to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission,
- 13 Sunshine Taxi's complaint against Ms. Cardin is
- 14 satisfied.
- 15 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ms. Cardin --
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- 17 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: -- you heard
- 18 Mr. Williams statements.
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- 20 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ma'am, you are
- 21 going to have to speak up.
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- 23 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Do you agree that
- 24 he has accurately stated the agreement between you and
- 25 Tazco -- Sunshine Taxi.

- MS. CARDIN: Yes, I do.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay.
- Mr. Williams, if you would likewise

## STIPULATION

Tazco, Inc. d/b/a Sunshine Taxi (Sunshine Taxi), Complainant, on the one hand, and Leslie G. Cardin, individually and/or d/b/a Designated Drivers (Ms. Cardin), a Respondent in the above case, submit their settlement stipulation in Docket No. 03F-164CP, stating as follows to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC or Commission):

- 1. Sunshine Taxi, on the one hand, and Ms. Cardin, on the other hand, also attach a copy of the transcript of July 17, 2003 relative to this settlement. A copy of the transcript is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- Ms. Cardin agrees that at one time she worked or was associated with Designated 2. Drivers as a driver. She further states that, in approximately April of 2003, she disassociated herself from Designated drivers and is no longer associated with Designated Drivers. She further agrees that she does not provide any for-hire, tip, or donation based transportation service currently, and will not do so in the future, without appropriate PUC authority. Ms. Cardin further consents to the entry of a cease and desist order against her for such activity.

- 3. Ms. Cardin also advises that she works as a school bus driver and Sunshine Taxi agrees with her that that working as a school bus driver does not require PUC authority, in Sunshine Taxi's view, and that terms of this stipulation do not prohibit such employment.
- 4. The parties agree that Sunshine Taxi intends for the stipulation to reach the geographic area of Sunshine Taxi's authority. Any for-hire, tip, or donation transportation services conducted by Ms. Cardin within Mesa County or to and from Mesa County within the scope of Sunshine Taxi's authority without appropriate PUC authorization, would, in Sunshine Taxi's opinion, be a violation of this agreement.
- 5. Sunshine Taxi agrees that the stipulation does not prohibit Ms. Cardin from working as an employee or independent contractor for a company or entity whose operations do not require PUC authority or where the company or entity has PUC authority and is conducting operations in compliance with the PUC authority.
- 6. Ms. Cardin reserves the right to file any PUC application of any type; and, Sunshine Taxi reserves the right to oppose any PUC application that Ms. Cardin may file.
- 7. The parties further stipulate that Ms. Cardin has been informed by the Administrative Law Judge that any violation of the stipulation would also violate an order of the PUC and the Commission could then go to court to seek an injunction to enforce its order and/or Ms. Cardin may be subject to civil penalties.
- 8. Ms. Cardin was also informed by the Administrative Law Judge that the PUC orders reach the entire state of Colorado.
- 9. If this stipulation is agreed to and accepted by the PUC, Sunshine Taxi's complaint against Ms. Cardin can be dismissed with prejudice.

- 21 addition, it's -- you would be violating an order of
- 22 the Public Utilities Commission and that the Commission
- 23 could then go to court to seek an injunction to enforce
- 24 its order or you might be subject to civil penalties
- 25 for violating the Commission's order?

- 1 So those are not issues that were
- 2 specifically addressed in the stipulation, but I want
- 3 to advise you that that is a possible outcome also of
- 4 signing the stipulation.
- So if you all want to think about that
- 6 for a second, let me know if that changes anything.
- 7 MR. SEGERS: That was already understood,
- 8 yeah. Yes.
- 9 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: The second thing
- 10 that I want to be sure everyone understands is what it
- 11 means to dismiss the counter-complaint with prejudice.
- 12 I would like to be sure that you all understand that
- 13 what that means is that you will not be able to bring
- 14 the counter-complaint or bring a complaint based on
- 15 those same allegations covering the same time period in
- 16 the future. So are you all aware of that, as well?
- MR. SEGERS: Yes.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Sir, in --
- MR. SEGERS: I am aware of that.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Mrs. Segers?
- MRS. SEGERS: Yes.
- 22 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: And finally I
- 23 would like to tell you my understanding of what
- 24 Mr. Williams read is that you all will agree, among a
- 25 lot of other thinks, not to do any donation based or

- 1 transportation operation either in your own names or in
- 2 association with anyone else; do you also understand
- 3 that?
- 4 MR. SEGERS: Yes, ma'am.
- 5 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ma'am?
- 6 MRS. SEGERS: Yes.
- 7 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, may I
- 8 interrupt?
- 9 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Certainly.
- MR. WILLIAMS: Without P.U.C.
- 11 authorization.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: I'm sorry,
- 13 without P.U.C. authorization. My apologies.
- 14 Do you all understand that?
- MR. SEGERS: Yes, ma'am.
- MRS. SEGERS: Yes.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay, thank you.
- With that understanding and pending
- 19 seeing the final written language -- but assuming the
- 20 language covers the substance of what I have heard
- 21 today, I believe that that stipulation with the
- 22 understanding that I've heard and statements from the
- 23 Segers and the various motions including the motion for
- 24 summary judgment that -- and appended affidavits are
- 25 supported -- support the stipulation and are sufficient

- 1 grounds for the Commission -- for me to recommend that
- 2 the stipulation be approved.
- 3 So that is pending receiving the final
- 4 language and having that language accurately reflect
- 5 what was read today -- but I think the stipulation
- 6 overall is sufficient to settle the case and is
- 7 acceptable to me.
- 8 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, may I be heard
- 9 just briefly?
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Uh-huh. On?
- MR. WILLIAMS: The -- just for Mr. and
- 12 Mrs. Segers -- I was just going to advise them that I'm
- 13 not going to try to remember this from my notes; I will
- 14 order this portion of the transcript from Mr. Midyett
- 15 and I will attach it to the draft so you can see that
- 16 it's exactly what I read into the record.
- MR. SEGERS: Okay.
- MRS. SEGERS: Okay.
- MR. WILLIAMS: So that I'm not going to
- 20 try to rely on my notes which at best are -- I think
- 21 are accurate but they are also -- you know, I've got
- 22 arrows and dots and dashes and everything else in
- 23 there. So just so you know, I will have the transcript
- 24 of what I just read into the record and the dialogue
- 25 that took place with the Administrative Law Judge

- 1 attached to the settlement stipulation as a further
- 2 exhibit so that you can see that we're submitting --
- 3 what we're submitting is exactly what we agreed to.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay. Now that,
- 5 I think, renders moot the following pending motions. I
- 6 want to get this on the record just so we wrap up some
- 7 things. It renders moot -- that is to say the
- 8 Commission does not need to make a decision on -- this
- 9 will take some time these are lengthy titles on the
- 10 following motions: The Motion in Limine limiting
- 11 participation of Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie
- 12 Segers in this case and/or requiring counsel for other
- 13 entities including the entity known as Darrel G. Segers
- 14 and Terry Marie Segers doing business as Designated
- 15 Drivers, the request for shortened response time --
- 16 excuse me, that motion is moot as a result of this.
- 17 Tazco's motion for summary judgment in
- 18 its complaint against Darrel G. Segers and Terry Marie
- 19 Segers is moot.
- 20 The second -- Tazco's second motion to
- 21 strike the response of Darrel Segers to the complaint
- 22 and for various other relief is also rendered moot.
- 23 Tazco's motion for modification of
- 24 certain portions of Recommended Decision R03-0710-I.
- And finally, the motion for leave to

- 1 amend the response to the amended counter-complaint is
- 2 also rendered moot.
- There is a pending motion which is not
- 4 addressed by the settlement reached as between the
- 5 Segers and Tazco; but -- yes, Mr. Williams?
- 6 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, you're
- 7 absolutely correct. They are rendered moot; however on
- 8 Tazco's behalf -- Sunshine Taxi's behalf, they are
- 9 rendered moot contingent on acceptance of the
- 10 stipulation and agreement and -- however I don't
- 11 anticipate a problem in that regard -- in the event the
- 12 stipulation is rejected or not completed by -- rejected
- 13 by the Administrative Law Judge or not completed, then
- 14 we would reserve the right to reoffer those without
- 15 refiling.
- And Mr. and Mrs. Segers -- may I address
- 17 them, Your Honor?

- 1 the only reason that we're not proceeding today is
- 2 because of the stipulation; and if for any reason -- we
- 3 hope it doesn't happen -- but if it does occur that the
- 4 stipulation is not reduced to writing and agreed to by
- 5 everyone, that in essence the case just resumes where
- 6 it is today.
- 7 Is that everyone's understanding?
- MR. SEGERS: Yeah, we understand that.
- 9 MRS. SEGERS: Yeah.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay, thank you.
- The only pending motion which is not
- 12 rendered moot by the stipulation is the Tazco motion
- 13 for entry of default against respondents Leslie G.
- 14 Cardin, Daniel J. McGuire and Kerrie A. Foster.
- 15 Mr. Williams, do you wish to address that motion?
- 16 MR. WILLIAMS: I do, Your Honor.
- May we go off the record for just a
- 18 minute. I need to speak with Ms. Cardin.
- 19 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: We'll take a five
- 20 minute recess.
- MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you.
- 22 (Recess.)
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: We'll be back on
- 24 the record.
- Mr. Williams, please address the motion

- for entry of default.
- 2 MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, with respect
- 3 to the motion for entry of default, I would like to
- 4 reserve for a moment my comments with respect to
- 5 Ms. Foster and Mr. McGuire and deal solely with
- 6 Ms. Cardin -- Ms. Leslie Cardin.
- 7 Ms. Cardin is present in the hearing room
- 8 and she and I have had discussions concerning her past
- 9 relationship with Designated Drivers; and, in fact, she
- 10 testified in the earlier case, the companion
- 11 application case Docket No. 03A-108CP.
- 12 Sunshine Taxi and Ms. Cardin have also
- 13 reached a tentative agreement with respect to
- 14 Sunshine's Taxi's claims against her, and they are as
- 15 follows: Ms. Cardin agrees that at one time she worked
- 16 or was associated with Designated Drivers as a driver.
- 17 And she also agrees that she, in approximately April of
- 18 2003, disassociated herself from Designated drivers and
- 19 is no longer associated with Designated Drivers. She
- 20 further agrees that she does not provided any
- 21 transportation for hire currently and will not in the
- 22 future without appropriate P.U.C. authority. By that I
- 23 mean a tip, donation type of service.
- 24 She does however recognize and Sunshine
- 25 Taxi agrees that if she wants to provide a truly free

- 1 service in other words, take a friend of hers home from
- 2 the bar with no compensation being paid, that she can
- 3 do that.
- Ms. Cardin also advises that she works as
- 5 a school bus driver and Sunshine Taxi agrees with her
- 6 that that does not require P.U.C. authority and the
- 7 terms of the stipulation do not reach that activity.
- 8 That is the terms of the settlement that
- 9 Sunshine Taxi has with Ms. Cardin. The terms of that
- 10 settlement are agreeable to Sunshine Taxi; and if
- 11 Ms. Cardin agrees to those terms and if the terms are
- 12 acceptable to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission,
- 13 Sunshine Taxi's complaint against Ms. Cardin is
- 14 satisfied.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ms. Cardin --
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: -- you heard
- 18 Mr. Williams statements.
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ma'am, you are
- 21 going to have to speak up.
- MS. CARDIN: Yes.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Do you agree that
- 24 he has accurately stated the agreement between you and
- 25 Tazco -- Sunshine Taxi.

- 1 MS. CARDIN: Yes, I do.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay.
- Mr. Williams, if you would likewise
- 4 reduce this to writing and submit it with appropriate
- 5 signatures, I think -- oh, I'm sorry, and Ms. Cardin,
- 6 did you also -- were you present when I told the --
- 7 discussed with the Segers what might happen if they
- 8 violated any Commission order?
- 9 MS. CARDIN: Yes, I was here.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: And do you
- 11 understand that the -- this agreement that Mr. Williams
- 12 just spoke into the record, if approved by the
- 13 Commission and becomes part of a Commission order may
- 14 result in your being -- having civil penalties or other
- 15 action taken against you if you violate it?
- MS. CARDIN: Yes, I do.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay, thank you.
- With that, I am satisfied at least on the
- 19 oral presentation that the stipulation should be
- 20 recommended for approval.
- 21 Mr. Williams, if you will reduce it to
- 22 writing as with the other stipulation --
- Yes, Ms. Cardin?
- MS. CARDIN: I have one question.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Certainly.

- MS. CARDIN: Is this in Mesa County? Am
- 2 I hearing you right?
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ma'am.
- MR. SEGERS: Anywhere.
- MS. CARDIN: The whole state of Colorado?
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: The whole state
- 7 of Colorado. Is that -- I need to know if that's a
- 8 problem, and I'm sure Mr. Williams needs to know as
- 9 well. If you could --
- MS. CARDIN: Well, you know, certain jobs
- 11 that I might obtain since I am a driver I might be put
- 12 in a position where I have to take -- transport
- 13 somebody, you know, and they may not be a student, they
- 14 may not be -- it may not be regulated by P.U.C. per se;
- 15 but will that affect -- will that affect me in a job
- 16 similar to that?
- Say if I go get a job at Sprint, they are
- 18 under P.U.C. regulations for packages and things like
- 19 that. But I don't know about their -- whether they are
- 20 covered to -- just a for instance -- for taking a
- 21 person; because sometimes they will have young children
- 22 or somebody like that needing to be transferred from
- 23 one town to another town in some kind of case or
- 24 something going on and that might -- they consider them
- 25 a package. But what this is stipulating is like if I

- 1 did that, would I be in violation?
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Okay,
- 3 Mr. Williams?
- 4 MR. WILLIAMS: Ms. Cardin, with respect
- 5 to the -- Sunshine Taxi's position on what you just
- 6 said is this: Sunshine Taxi intends for the
- 7 stipulation to reach the geographic area of Sunshine
- 8 Taxi's authority, the same as I stated with
- 9 Mr. and Mrs. Segers. So if you want to do something
- 10 from Fort Collins to Pueblo, that's outside the scope
- 11 of Sunshine Taxi's authority; and even if we would
- 12 contend it was wrong, we wouldn't do anything about it.
- 13 If you do something that you just
- 14 described, transport a person within Mesa County or to
- 15 and from Mesa County within the scope of Sunshine
- 16 Taxi's authority without appropriate P.U.C.
- 17 authorization -- without appropriate P.U.C.
- 18 authorization, it is a problem for Sunshine Taxi; and
- 19 it would be, in Sunshine Taxi's opinion, a violation of
- 20 this agreement.
- MS. CARDIN: Uh-huh.
- 22 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: The Commission's
- 23 orders, Ms. Cardin, reach the entire state of
- 24 Colorado --
- MS. CARDIN: Uh-huh.

- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: -- without
- 2 limiting language in the stipulation itself, the
- 3 assumption would be that the Commission's order reaches
- 4 the entire state of Colorado. Whether or not the
- 5 specific actions that you just described, for instance,
- 6 the Sprint situation, would be a violation, I can't --
- 7 I'm not going to speculate about that because that
- 8 situation isn't before me and hasn't been factually
- 9 developed. So I'm not in a position to answer that
- 10 part of the question.
- But I can tell you that the presumption
- 12 is that the order covers the whole state.
- MS. CARDIN: That's what my presumption
- 14 is. So should we reword that just a little so that
- 15 it -- because that's my occupation, driving.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Why don't we take
- 17 another five minutes and Mr. Williams and Ms. Cardin
- 18 you all get together.
- MS. CARDIN: I'm sorry to be so
- 20 difficult. I don't want to tie myself up in my career.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ma'am, you are
- 22 not being difficult. I want to make that very clear
- 23 you are doing what you need to do to be sure you
- 24 understand exactly what you are agreeing to. I think I
- 25 have no problem with that and I think it's very helpful

- 1 for you to be doing it now rather than later. So with
- 2 that, Mr. Williams, Ms. Cardin, if you all would talk
- 3 for a few minutes.
- 4 MS. CARDIN: Thank you.
- 5 (Recess.)
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: We'll be back on
- 7 the record.
- 8 Mr. Williams, Ms. Cardin did you have an
- 9 opportunity to have a discussion during the break?
- MR. WILLIAMS: We did, Your Honor.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: And what if
- 12 anything is the result?
- MR. WILLIAMS: Your Honor, we're
- 14 reaffirming what I earlier read into the record; and to
- 15 address Ms. Cardin's stated concerns, we're adding
- 16 these further provisions, as follows: Sunshine Taxi
- 17 agrees that the stipulation does not prohibit
- 18 Ms. Cardin from working as an employee or independent
- 19 contractor for a company or entity whose operations do
- 20 not require P.U.C. authority or where the company or
- 21 entity has P.U.C. authority and is conducting
- 22 operations in compliance with it -- with the P.U.C.
- 23 authority.
- Ms. Cardin reserves the right to file any
- 25 P.U.C. application of any type she wants, Sunshine Taxi

- 1 reserves the right to oppose any P.U.C. application
- 2 that Ms. Cardin may file.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Ms. Cardin, is
- 4 that -- is that both understandable and agreeable?
- 5 MS. CARDIN: Yes, ma'am, it is.
- A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Thank you, ma'am.
- With that additional clarifying
- 8 language -- Ms. Cardin I want to thank you for bringing
- 9 that up so you could get that straightened out before
- 10 future problems arose.
- The agreement as between Ms. Cardin and
- 12 Tazco is acceptable; and assuming it is reduced to
- 13 writing and filed with the Commission in substantially
- 14 the same language as has been read today, will be
- 15 agreeable -- will be acceptable.
- MS. CARDIN: Thank you.
- 17 A.L.J. JENNINGS-FADER: Finally,
- 18 Mr. Williams, that leaves us with the respondents
- 19 Darrel J. McGuire and Kerrie A. Foster. I think that's
- 20 all that's left on the motion for default. Could you
- 21 address that, please.
- MR. WILLIAMS: Yes, Your Honor.
- 23 (PURSUANT to request of ordering counsel,
- 24 the continued hearing was not transcribed.)
