I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. On May 14, 2004, an administrative law judge (ALJ) for the Commission issued Decision No. R04-0509 recommending adoption of permanent rules regarding the provisioning of the abbreviated dialing code 5-1-1. Pursuant to § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., Decision No. R04-0509 will become the decision of the Commission if no exceptions are filed within 20 days after service of the ALJ's order. However, § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., permits the Commission to stay a recommended decision upon its own motion.

2. The Commission will stay Decision No. R04-0509 on its own motion to allow for Commission review of the recommendations of the ALJ. At a future Commissioners' Meeting, the Commission shall review the ALJ's recommendation along with any exceptions filed within 20 days after Decision No. R04-0509 was mailed.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. In accordance with the provisions of § 40-6-109(2), C.R.S., Decision No. R04-0509 mailed May 14, 2004, is stayed.

2. This Order is effective upon its Mailed Date.
