I. STATEMENT

1. On December 15, 2016, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to amend the Rules Regulating Railroads, Rail Fixed Guideways, Transportation by Rail, and Rail Crossings contained in 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-7. The Commission referred this matter to an administrative law judge and scheduled the commencement of the hearing for January 30, 2017. *See* Decision No. C16-1146.

2. At the scheduled time and place, the hearing was convened. By Decision No. R17-0090-I, the oral announcement during hearing was memorialized to continue the hearing. This decision memorializes the oral announcement further continuing the hearing as ordered below.

3. After preliminary consideration of comments to date, additional redlined modifications (appearing in blue) are attached hereto as Attachment A to facilitate further discussion and comment during hearing. Also, comment suggests using the definition of highway found in the

Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) in proposed Rule 7201(u).
Please provide a citation language of the definition proposed.
