1. The second sentence of paragraph 52 on page 23 of this Decision reads as:

That sentence states that members of the public will be receiving instructions for telephonic participation in a separate decision that will be issued prior to the scheduled hearing. That is

incorrect. The instructions for telephonic participation will be sent in a notice. The second sentence of paragraph 52 will be amended to read as follows:

Members of the public may enter a queue to provide oral comments by dialing a number for telephonic participation to be published with further instructions in a separate notice to be issued prior to the scheduled hearing.
