SCHEDULING PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS**

**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement**

1. On June 14, 2024, Black Hills Colorado Electric, LLC, doing business as Black Hills Energy (“BHCOE” or the “Company”), filed Advice Letter No. 871 (“AL 871”) with tariff sheets to revise base rate revenue for all electric service in the Company’s Colorado PUC No. 11 Tariff, along with certain other changes to its tariff.

2. By Decision No. C24-0489, issued July 9, 2024, the Commission set for hearing and suspended the effective date of the tariff sheets filed with AL 871 pursuant to § 40-6-111(1), C.R.S.

3. By Decision No. C24-0608-I, issued August 21, 2024, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule that includes dates for an evidentiary hearing of December 2 through 6, 2024, and December 9 through 11, 2024.

4. This Decision adds four public comment hearings to the procedural schedule in this matter.

**B. Discussion, Findings, and Conclusions**

5. Through AL 871, BHCOE requests an annual revenue increase of some \$37 million above its current base rate revenue of \$180 million. The Company's proposals for establishing new base rates, if approved by the Commission, would cause an increase in bills to Residential customers of approximately 18 percent and an increase in bills to Small Commercial customers of approximately 10 percent.

6. Based on the significant increase in bills for electric service sought by BHCOE, we find good cause to schedule public comment hearings in this matter.

7. We will conduct two public comment hearings in Pueblo, Colorado, the first on Tuesday, October 29, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., and the second on Wednesday, October 30, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Both hearings will take place at Pueblo Memorial Hall, One City Hall Place, Pueblo, CO 81003.

8. Another public comment hearing shall be held in Cañon City, Colorado, on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The hearing will take place at City Council Chambers, 128 Main Street, Cañon City, CO 81212.

9. In addition, we will conduct a remote public comment hearing on Thursday, December 5, 2024, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The remote public comment hearing will be held using the web-based video conferencing Zoom platform. Members of the public cannot attend the remote public comment hearing in-person. Additional information about participation in the public comment hearings, such as the sign-up sheet, and all relevant information on how to log on to the

remote public comment hearings will be made available on the Commission's public calendar at: <https://puc.colorado.gov/pucalendar>.

10. The remote public comment hearing will be webcast on the Commission's website. This means that those persons wishing to observe but not participate in the public comment hearing may do so by watching the webcast. To observe the remote public comment hearing, enter this link in the web browser <https://puc.colorado.gov/webcasts> and select the audio or video option for Hearing Room A. The Commission encourages interested persons who do not wish to provide comments at the remote public comment hearing to observe it through the webcast rather than Zoom. Doing so will help minimize background noise during the hearing and may assist in the orderly progression of the hearing.

11. A court reporter will live transcribe each of the public comment hearings to create a written record of the comments received. Commenters should give their full name, and spell it, before they give their comments. In general, commenters will be called to speak in the order in which they sign up. The presiding officer may adopt procedures and time limits for comments as necessary to ensure that all members of the public have opportunity to comment, and the transcribed record is clear and understandable. Typical time limits range from one to three minutes for each commenter. To ensure the hearing time is used efficiently, commenters are requested to avoid repetitive comments that re-state filed written comments or repeat oral comments already provided at hearing. As discussed below, written public comment can be filed at any time in the proceeding and will be afforded the same weight as oral comments. Finally, the purpose of a public comment hearing is to provide opportunity for members of the public to provide oral comments.

To that end, parties to the Proceeding and their representatives are not permitted to present comments. Individuals may present comments on their own behalf.

12. The Commission will publicize the public comment hearings by press release, announce them on the Commission's public calendar, and make it known by other avenues to the extent resources are available.

13. Participating in the public comment hearing is not the only way to provide comments in this Proceeding. We encourage interested persons to provide written or oral public comments at any time this Proceeding is open. Please include "Proceeding No. 24AL-0275E" in the public comments. Public comments can be provided by:
