I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of an Unopposed Motion to Late File an Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention (“Motion”) filed by Union Pacific Railroad Company (“UPRR”) on November 13, 2024, and the Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention of UPRR.

2. On November 6, 2024, the Commission approved the Application to install a sidewalk at crossing #253531V (“Railroad Avenue Crossing”) of the UPRR Tennessee Pass Subdivision at railroad milepost 301.62 in Minturn, Colorado. This Decision was not issued until November 15, 2024.

3. On November 13, 2024, UPRR filed its Motion and intervention in this matter. UPRR did not contest or oppose the Application.

4. Now being fully advised in the matter, we note UPRR's late Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Unopposed Motion to Late File an Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention ("Motion") filed by Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UPRR") on November 13, 2024, and the Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention of UPRR is noted.

2. The 20-day period provided for in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file an Application for Rehearing, Reargument, or Reconsideration, begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions as necessary.

4. This Decision is effective upon its Issued Date.
