I. STATEMENT

A. Background

1. On July 17, 2023, the City and County of Denver (Denver) filed the Petition for Declaratory Order (Petition) that initiated this proceeding.

2. On August 7, 2023, the Commission issued Decision No. C23-0516-I that accepted the Petition and referred the proceeding to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) by minute entry. The proceeding was subsequently assigned to the undersigned ALJ.

3. On August 16, 2023, Public Service filed a Notice of Intervention by Right or Alternative Motion for Permissive Intervention (Notice/Alternative Motion).

4. On September 6, 2023, Trial Staff of the Commission filed a Notice of Intervention as of Right, Entry of Appearance, and Request for Hearing.

5. On October 3, 2023, the ALJ issued Decision No. R23-0658-I that adopted the following schedule in this proceeding:

6. The parties filed initial and responsive comments within the deadlines stated above.

7. On January 23, 2024, Denver filed a Joint Motion to Vacate Oral Argument (Joint Motion).

B. Remote Prehearing Conference

8. The Joint Motion states good cause to vacate the oral argument. Accordingly, the oral argument scheduled for February 1, 2024 will be vacated.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Joint Motion to Vacate Oral Argument is granted.
2. The oral argument scheduled for February 1, 2024, is vacated.
