I. **STATEMENT**

> On December 1, 2023, Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association, Inc. 1.

("Tri-State") filed an Application for Approval of its 2023 Electric Resource Plan. The filing of

the Application commenced this Proceeding.

By Decision No. R24-0138-I, issued March 5, 2024, the undersigned 2.

Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), among other things, adopted a procedural schedule to

govern this Proceeding. According to the procedural schedule adopted by Decision No.

R24-0138-I, the deadline for the filing of any Settlement Agreements is June 26, 2024.

3. On June 25, 2024, the undersigned ALJ received informal correspondence from

Tri-State's counsel on behalf of the parties in this Proceeding, indicating that a significant

number of parties, including Tri-State, have reached a comprehensive settlement in principle in

this Proceeding. Tri State's counsel further indicated that Tri-State has conferred with all parties

to this Proceeding and no party opposed the proposed settlement. Based on the foregoing,

Tri-State's counsel requested to extend the deadline for the submission of any Settlement Agreements until June 27, 2024.

4. Based on the foregoing, the ALJ finds good cause to extend the filing deadline for any settlement agreements through June 28, 2024, as ordered below.

II. ORDER

A. It is Ordered That:

- 1. Consistent with the discussion above, the deadline for the filing of any settlement agreements is extended through June 28, 2024.
 - 2. This Decision is effective immediately.
