EXTENSION OF TIME**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a request submitted on September 8, 2025, by MedRide, LLC (“MedRide”) for an extension of time to satisfy all conditions in Decision R25-0439.

2. On September 20, 2024, MedRide filed an Application for permanent authority to operate as a contract carrier of passengers by motor vehicle for hire. MedRide filed an amended application on September 27, 2024. In this Application, MedRide requested permanent authority to operate as a contract carrier and provide transportation for the Mesa County Valley School District No. 51, VOANS Senior Community Care of Colorado in the Counties of Delta, Mesa, and Montrose, and St. Mary’s Regional Hospital in Grand Junction, Colorado.,

3. The Commission noticed this Application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on October 8, 2024. Tazco, Inc., doing business as Sunshine Taxi, timely filed a Notice of Intervention by Right on November 6, 2024.

4. The Application was referred to an administrative law judge by minute entry at the Commissioner's weekly meeting of November 13, 2024.

5. On June 6, 2025, Recommended Decision No. R25-0439 granted the Application, as amended, subject to MedRide's compliance with the requirements named in Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of the Decision.

6. Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of the Decision required MedRide to file proof of insurance; pay the motor vehicle fee and issuance fee; submit an advice letter and tariff; register with the Commission's electronic filing system and submit the appropriate inspections of the vehicles to be operated.

7. The Decision required MedRide to comply with each of these requirements within 60 days of its effective date of June 26, 2025. Therefore, MedRide had until August 25, 2025, to complete the requirements of Ordering Paragraph No. 7.

8. MedRide did not submit the advice letter and tariff required by Ordering Paragraph No. 7(c) of the Decision by August 25, 2025.

9. To support the request for an extension of time, MedRide states "The reason for the request is due to a lack of understanding of the submission process. This was our first contract (carrier application) of this kind and we did not fully understand the process."

10. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of the Decision states "For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within 60 days of the effective date of this Decision."

11. The Motion requesting the granting additional time was not filed within the 60-day period.

12. However, the Commission finds that MedRide has shown good cause to grant the requested 25 days of time to complete the compliance requirements.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion submitted by MedRide, LLC, on September 8, 2025, requesting that the Commission grant an extension of time to complete the requirements set forth in Decision No. R25-0439, is granted.

2. MedRide, LLC is granted an additional 25 days from the effective date of this Decision to comply with the requirements set forth in Decision No. R24-0439.

3. The 20-day period provided in § 40-6-114, C.R.S., within which to file an Application for Rehearing, Reargument, or Reconsideration begins on the first day following the effective date of this Decision.

4. This Decision is effective immediately upon its Issued Date.
