**INTERIM DECISION GRANTING RYE TELEPHONE
COMPANY, SOUTH PARK TELEPHONE COMPANY, AND
CABLECO, LLC'S REQUESTS FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME**

I. STATEMENT

1. On January 2, 2025, the Commission opened the above-captioned repository Proceeding for those subject to Rules 2006 and 2187 of the Rules Regulating Telecommunications Services and Providers of Telecommunications Services, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (“CCR”) 723-2 to file 2024 Annual Reports (“Reports”) under Rule 2187(g)(IX) and DR525 Forms (“DR525”) under Rule 2006.

2. On January 22, 2025, the Commission referred this proceeding to an Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) by minute entry for the disposition of all pleadings and motions filed.

3. On April 16, 2025, Rye Telephone Company, South Park Telephone Company, and CableCo, LLC (“the Companies”) each filed a Request for Extension of Time (“Motion”).

4. On April 17, 2025, the Companies again filed Requests for Extension of Time. The Requests for Extension of Time appear to be identical to the filings made on April 16, 2025.

II. RELEVANT LAW, ANALYSIS, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

5. Since this is an administrative proceeding (and not an adjudicative one), the ALJ waives the response time to the Motion.¹

6. Rule 2187(g)(IX) required certain telecommunication carriers to submit an annual report using Commission-prescribed forms on or before April 30 of each year.²

7. The Companies ask for extensions of time to file their Reports.³ As grounds, the Companies state that their 2024 financial statements are expected in mid-May and they will file the reports promptly upon completion of the financial statements.⁴

8. The Companies do not request additional time to file their Form DR525s, explaining that they will file the DR525s on time.⁵

9. The ALJ concludes that the Motions provide good cause for a 30-day extension of time to file the Reports; as such, the Motions are granted. Rye Telephone Company, South Park Telephone Company, and CableCo, LLC's 2024 Reports must be filed by May 30, 2025.

III. ORDER

A. It is Ordered That:

1. Response time to the Requests for Extension of Time ("Motions") filed by Rye Telephone Company, South Park Telephone Company, and CableCo, LLC ("the Companies") on April 16, 2025, is waived and the Motions are granted.

2. Identical Requests for Extension of Time filed by the Companies on April 17, 2025 are denied as moot.

3. Rye Telephone Company, South Park Telephone Company, and CableCo, LLC's 2024 Annual Reports required by Rule 2187(g)(IX) of the Rules Regulating Telecommunications Services and Providers of Telecommunications Services, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-2 must be filed on or before May 30, 2025.

4. This Decision does not extend or otherwise impact the deadline for Rye Telephone Company, South Park Telephone Company, or CableCo, LLC to file their 2024 DR525 Forms.

5. This Decision is effective immediately.
