1                   **RULES PRESCRIBING THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY**  
2                   **REPORTING SERVICES FOR EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATIONS**  
3                   **SERVICE PROVIDERS AND TELEPHONE UTILITIES**

6                   **RULE 3: PROCESS FOR CERTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS**

7                   **3.1**     The Commission finds and declares that the public convenience and necessity require  
8                   the provision of Basic Emergency Service within each local exchange area within the State  
9                   of Colorado, and that such Basic Emergency Service is vital to the public health and safety  
10                  and shall be provided, **AS SOON AS REASONABLY PRACTICABLE**, solely by properly  
11                  certificated Local Exchange Providers.

12  
13                  **3.2**     A Local Exchange Provider certificated to serve a specific geographic area pursuant  
14                  to §§ 40-5-101 through 40-5-103, C.R.S., shall be authorized to provide Basic Emergency  
15                  Service within its service area without having to obtain a new certificate, but shall file with  
16                  the Commission a report detailing the means by which it will provide the services, as more  
17                  specifically required in Rule 3.4.

18  
19                  **3.2.1** THE COMMISSION, UPON RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT, OR UPON ITS OWN  
20                  MOTION, MAY DETERMINE THAT THE EXISTING CERTIFICATED LOCAL  
21                  EXCHANGE PROVIDER IN A PARTICULAR GEOGRAPHIC AREA IS UNWILLING  
22                  OR UNABLE TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE BASIC EMERGENCY SERVICE. WHERE

1 SUCH A DETERMINATION IS MADE THE COMMISSION MAY, FOR THE  
2 LIMITED PURPOSE OF PROVIDING BASIC EMERGENCY SERVICE, CERTIFY  
3 THE APPLICATION OF ANOTHER LOCAL EXCHANGE PROVIDER TO OFFER  
4 THE SERVICE. THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE ADEQUACY OF  
5 SERVICE ACCORDING TO VARIOUS FACTORS, INCLUDING THE PRICE OF  
6 SUCH SERVICE.

7  
8 **3.3** An application for authority to provide Basic Emergency Service in areas outside of  
9 its certificated local exchange area shall contain the following information:

10 **3.3.1** The name, address, and telephone number of the applicant.

11 **3.3.2** The name, if different than above, under which the applicant will provide  
12 Basic Emergency Service(s);

13  
14 **3.3.3** If the APPLICANT IS A COMPANY OR CORPORATION ~~application is a:~~

15 ~~**3.3.3.1** Company or corporation:~~

16 **3.3.3.1.1** A statement of that fact, the state in which it is incorporated, and, if an  
17 out-of-state corporation, a copy of the authority qualifying it to do business in  
18 Colorado;

19 **3.3.3.1.2** Location of its principal office, if any, in this state;

20 **3.3.3.1.3** A copy of its Articles of Incorporation.

- 1     **3.3.3.2**     IF THE APPLICANT IS A [p]artnership or copartnership:
- 2     **3.3.3.2.1**    The name, title and business address of each partner, both general and  
3                    limited;
- 4     **3.3.3.2.2**    A copy of the partnership agreement establishing the partnership and later  
5                    amendments, if any.

- 7     ~~**3.3.3.3**     City, State or county government, agency of a city, state or county, or a~~  
8                    ~~political subdivision, state department, commission, board, bureau or~~

- 15    **3.3.3.4**     IF THE APPLICANT IS [a]n association or stock association:
- 16    **3.3.3.4.1**    A statement of that fact;
- 17    **3.3.3.4.2**    The names, addresses and titles of each of the members of the association or  
18                    stock association;
- 19    **3.3.3.4.3**    A copy of the authority qualifying it to do business in Colorado, sales tax  
20                    licenses, Federal Employer Identification Number;

1     **3.3.3.4.4**     Location of its principal office, if any, in this state;

3     **3.3.4**         The geographic area intended to be served pursuant to the application.

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5     **3.3.5**         The name, address, and telephone number of the Local Exchange Provider  
6                     certificated to serve the geographic area which is the subject of the  
7                     application.

8

9     **3.4.**     A detailed statement of the means by which the applicant will provide the services.

10    This includes, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO: (1) the technical specifications for the system  
11    that will be utilized to provide the Basic Emergency Services, ~~—The technical specifications~~  
12    ~~shall provide~~ INCLUDING information on emergency restoration of the system; (2) ANY  
13    INTER-COMPANY AGREEMENT USED TO IMPLEMENT AND OPERATE THE  
14    SERVICE; (3) ANY AGREEMENT WITH ALI DATABASE PROVIDERS; (4) ANY  
15    INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS REGARDING GOVERNING BODIES  
16    AND/OR PSAPS.

18    **3.5**     A current financial statement showing the applicant's assets, liabilities, and net worth  
19    are sufficient to provide Basic Emergency Service and/or ALI Database Service as defined  
20    by these rules;

1     **3.6**     The name and address of the applicant's representative or agent, if any, to whom all  
2     inquiries should be made;

4     **3.7**     EACH BASIC EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDER SHALL PROVIDE BASIC  
5     EMERGENCY SERVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH QUALITY OF SERVICE RULES  
6     AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE LATER ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION.

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
