**COMMISSION ORDER
GRANTING SUSPENSION**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. Also at that time, this matter was set for hearing before the Commission on September 28, 1995.

2. No protest, objection, or petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is therefore noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without an oral hearing.

3. Applicant has requested to suspend the authority for a period of six months from the effective date of this Order. To grant the request for a suspension would be in the public interest. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be suspended from August 24, 1995 through February 24, 1996.
4. The evidence submitted warrants the approval of a suspension of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394 as here ordered.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for September 28, 1995 is hereby vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on August 24, 1995, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5.
3. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394 is authorized by the Commission for a period of up to six months from the effective date of this Order.
4. On or before December 22, 1995, Applicant shall file a written request either for an extension of this suspension period, or a request to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394. Prior to reinstatement, insurance and tariffs shall

be filed. The failure to file a written request either for an extension of suspension or reinstatement of the certificate and filing of insurance and tariffs will result in revocation of the authority without further notice.

B. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
