I. **BY THE COMMISSION:** 

> Α. **Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

On December 19, 2002, University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger 1.

Express, filed an application for permanent authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier

Permit No. B-9790 to include the transportation of passengers and their baggage, between the La

Quinta Inn, Inc., 6801 Tower Road, Denver, Colorado, on the one hand, and Denver International

Airport, on the other hand. This application is restricted to providing transportation service for

only the La Quinta Inn, Inc., 6801 Tower Road, Denver, Colorado 80249.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on December 30, 2002. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on March 3, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested authority.
- 5. A present and special need for the requested transportation services exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

## II. ORDER


## **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for March 3, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on February 3, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger Express, is authorized to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9790 as requested in this application.
- 4. The complete authority under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9790, as extended, shall be as set forth in the Appendix and this Order is a permit.
- 5. University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger Express, as the holder of Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9790, shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
- 6. University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger Express, shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger Express, shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger

Director

Express, may not begin extended operations until these requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission stating it is in compliance and may begin service.

- 7. If University Services, Inc., doing business as Passenger Express, does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to extend operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
  - 8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
