**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement**

1. On January 30, 2003, Rocky Mountain Limousine, Inc., doing business as Ramblin' Express, Inc., (Ramblin' Express), filed an application for authority to publish Time Schedules Nos. 3,4,6 to become effective on less-than-statutory notice. Ramblin' Express provides scheduled service between Colorado Springs, Castle Rock, Woodland Park and Pueblo and Black Hawk and Cripple Creek.

2. Ramblin' Express proposes to add scheduled stops to an equivalent level to the number of last year's stops before schedules were reduced in December 2002.

3. In support of the application Ramblin' Express states that loss in revenue from last year's changes far out weighs the cost savings that resulted from those schedule changes.

4. Rule 31(f)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1, allows an order authorizing carriers to change tariffs or time schedules on less-than-statutory notice for good cause shown.

5. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown for the approval of the proposed changes in Time Schedules Nos. 3, 4, 6 and that the application should be granted.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

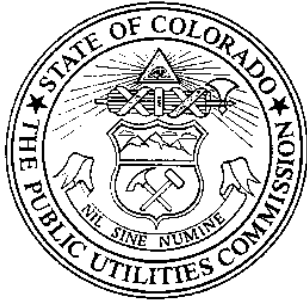
1. The application of Rocky Mountain Limousine, Inc., doing business as Ramblin' Express, Inc., to publish Time Schedules Nos. 3, 4, 6 on less-than-statutory notice is granted.

2. Time Schedules Nos. 3, 4, 6 shall be published on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the general public.

3. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
