I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On February 6, 2003, Thought Products, LLC, doing business as Compucab, filed

an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience

and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55694.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on February 10, 2003. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on April 17, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with the application warrants the grant of the requested

suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55694 is in the public interest.

#### II. **ORDER**

#### A. **The Commission Orders That:**

- 1. The hearing set for April 17, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on March 11, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Thought Products, LLC, doing business as Compucab, for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55694 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55694 is authorized from February 1, 2003 through January 31, 2004.
- 5. On or before December 31, 2003, Thought Products, LLC, doing business as Compucab, shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Thought Products, LLC, doing business as Compucab, shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee. If the suspension period is to extend beyond January 31, 2004, Thought Products, LLC, doing business as Compucab, shall file a written request by December 31, 2003, to extend the suspension period.
- 6. The failure to timely file the proper insurance may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

- 7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
