I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. On March 4, 2003, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) submitted its Notice of Filing

Ninth Revised Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions and Motion for Approval.

By that filing, Qwest requested Commission approval of a number of changes to its Statement of

Generally Available Terms and Conditions (SGAT). One of the changes proposed by Qwest in

the Ninth Revised SGAT concerned rates for Enhanced Extended Loops (EELs) Channel

Performance.¹ AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., and WorldCom, Inc.,

objected to Qwest's proposed EEL rates.

2. In Decision No. C03-0464 (Mailed Date of May 5, 2003), we allowed most of the

Ninth Revised SGAT to take effect, in accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(f), including the

proposed EEL rates. We stated, however, that the Commission would investigate in a separate

docket the new rates for EEL Channel Performance. See Decision No. C03-0464, paragraph 5.

¹ EELs comprise unbundled loops, multiplexing/concentrating equipment, and dedicated transport.

Consistent with the discussion in Decision No. C03-0464, we now open this docket for the purpose of investigating EEL rates proposed in Qwest's Ninth Revised SGAT.
