**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING SCHEDULE
CHANGES ON LESS-THAN-STATUTORY NOTICE**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement

1. On April 15, 2003, Shamrock Taxi of Ft. Collins, Inc., doing business as Shamrock Shuttle (“Shamrock Shuttle”) filed an application for authority to publish Time Schedule No. 9 to become effective on less-than-statutory notice. Shamrock Shuttle provides scheduled service between points in Larimer County and Denver International Airport.

2. Shamrock Shuttle proposes to delay departures from Denver International Airport fifteen minutes but maintain the same scheduled stops at Longmont, Loveland, and Fort Collins.

3. In support of the application, Shamrock Shuttle states that Denver International Airport is moving the Shamrock Shuttle pick-up location from Door 504 to Door 513 thereby causing a delay of fifteen minutes. However, by utilizing the E470 toll way Shamrock Shuttle will be able to maintain the remainder of its extant schedule.

4. Rule 31(f)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1, allows an order authorizing carriers to change tariffs or time schedules on less-than-statutory notice for good cause shown.

5. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown for the approval of the proposed changes in Time Schedule No. 9 and the application should be granted.

II. ORDER

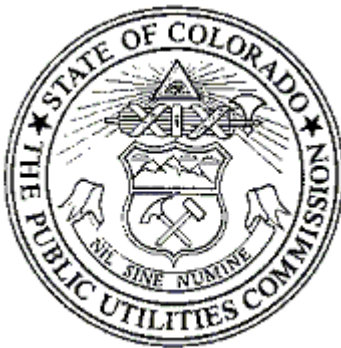
A. The Commission Orders That:
