I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement and Findings of Fact

1. On May 5, 2003, TeleCents Communications, Inc., filed a letter to withdraw its

certificate as a competitive local exchange carrier in the State of Colorado. The Commission

will construe this letter as a motion to withdraw.

2. On September 14, 2001, the Commission granted TeleCents Communications,

Inc., a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange

telecommunications services and a Letter of Registration to provide emerging competitive

telecommunications services. See Decision No. C01-940.

3. TeleCents Communications, Inc., represents that it has no local exchange

customers and has never operated as a competitive local exchange carrier in the State of

Colorado. Therefore, TeleCents Communications, Inc., asserts that termination of its authority

will have no adverse impact upon customers.

4. TeleCents Communications, Inc., has never filed tariffs to provide local exchange or emerging competitive telecommunications services in Colorado.

- 5. TeleCents Communications, Inc., is registered as a reseller of long distance telecommunications services in Colorado, and will continue to provide such services.
- 6. TeleCents Communications, Inc., has provided sufficient information for the Commission to take appropriate action relating to this matter.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. TeleCents Communications, Inc.'s motion to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange telecommunications services and its Letter of Registration to provide emerging competitive telecommunications services is granted.
- 2. As a toll reseller, TeleCents Communications, Inc., shall continue to have an obligation to file an annual report with the Commission and to contribute to the Commission's Fixed Utilities Fund and the Colorado High Cost Support Mechanism.
 - 3. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
