2. This case concerns proposed rules for simplified regulatory treatment of rural local exchange providers. We issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in this docket on December 19, 2002, and assigned the matter to the ALJ for hearing. *See* Decision No. C02-1407. After hearing in this case, the ALJ issued Decision No. R03-0492 R03-0402 recommending that the Commission adopt certain rules (Attachment A to the Recommended Decision). The rules recommended for adoption by the ALJ establish simplified regulatory procedures for rural local exchange providers. Specific statutory authority for adoption of rules establishing simplified regulation for rural providers is contained in §§ 40-15-201(1), 40-15-203.5, and 40-15-503(2)(d), C.R.S.
