I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On June 2, 2003, Stanley Brothers Taxi Company (Stanley Brothers), filed an

application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle

for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, in taxi service, between all points

within an 18-mile radius of the intersection of U.S. Highways 34 and 36 in Estes Park, Colorado,

and between said points, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport, on the other hand.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 2, 2003. The Commission set this matter

for hearing on August 6, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested authority.

- 5. The present or future public convenience and necessity requires, or will require, the transportation service as requested.
- 6. Stanley Brothers is ready, willing, and able to properly perform the service as requested.
  - 7. This application for permanent authority is in the public interest.

## II. ORDER

## **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for August 6, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on July 9, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. Stanley Brothers Taxi Company is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.
- 4. Stanley Brothers Taxi Company shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
- 5. Stanley Brothers Taxi Company shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Stanley Brothers Taxi Company shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Stanley Brothers

Taxi Company may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission stating it is in compliance and may begin service.

- 6. If Stanley Brothers Taxi Company does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
  - 7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
