**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On May 16, 2003, Summit Stage/Summit County Government, filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle under permit number B-9804.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 2, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on August 4, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The submitted information warrants the grant of the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend contract carrier permit number B-9804 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for August 4, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete July 7, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Summit Stage/Summit County Government for authority to suspend operations under contract carrier permit number B-9804 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under contract carrier permit number B-9804 is authorized from July 1, 2003 through July 1, 2004.
5. On or before June 1, 2004, Summit Stage/Summit County Government shall file a written request either to reinstate contract carrier permit number B-9804 or to extend the suspension period.
6. Prior to reinstatement, Summit Stage/Summit County Government shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Summit Stage/Summit County Government shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate contract carrier permit number B-9804 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the permit without further notice.

8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.

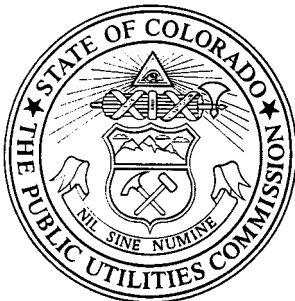
