## I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

## A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

- 1. On June 6, 2003, Executive Luxury Limousines, Inc., doing business as My Chauffeur Limousine Service Inc/Overland Express Inc, filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 49134.
- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 16, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on August 14, 2003.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested suspension.
- 5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 49134 is in the public interest.

#### II. **ORDER**

#### A. **The Commission Orders That:**

- 1. The hearing set for August 14, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on July 23, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Executive Luxury Limousines, Inc., doing business as My Chauffeur Limousine Service Inc/Overland Express Inc, for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 49134 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 49134 is authorized from February 20, 2003 through August 20, 2003.
- 5. On or before August 20, 2003, Executive Luxury Limousines, Inc., doing business as My Chauffeur Limousine Service Inc/Overland Express Inc, shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 49134 or to extend the suspension period.
- 6. Prior to reinstatement, Executive Luxury Limousines, Inc., doing business as My Chauffeur Limousine Service Inc/Overland Express Inc, shall cause to be filed with the

Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Executive Luxury Limousines, Inc., doing business as My Chauffeur Limousine Service Inc/Overland Express Inc, shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.

- 7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 49134 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.
  - 8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
