DECISION APPROVING REPORT OF ADOPTION OF PREVIOUSLY APPROVED INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

- 1. This matter comes before the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on the submittal of a Report of Adoption of Previously Approved Interconnection Agreement (Report of Adoption) filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and New Age Electronics, Inc. (New Age), pursuant to Commission Rule 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-44-6.¹
- 2. The parties filed this Report of Adoption on July 9, 2003. New Age has elected to adopt Qwest's Ninth Revised Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions for Interconnection, Unbundled Network Elements, Ancillary Services, and Resale of Telecommunication Services (SGAT). The Ninth Revised SGAT became effective on May 3, 2003 pursuant to Commission Decision No. C03-0464, mailed May 5, 2003. On June 13, 2003,

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consistent with the Decision, Qwest filed a revised Exhibit C and Exhibit G to the SGAT and revised Colorado PUC Tariff No. 22.

- 3. The parties have complied with the requirements of 4 CCR 723-44 *et seq*. for the submission for approval of interconnection agreements. Additionally, the Report of Adoption contains all information required in 4 CCR 723-44-6.
- 4. Pursuant to § 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act), 47 U.S.C. § 252(i), an incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement or amendment previously approved by this Commission to which the ILEC is a party to any other requesting local exchange carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement.
- 5. Section 47 U.S.C. § 251 *et seq.* of the Act requires that the Commission review and approve or reject interconnection agreements involving ILECs like Qwest. To comply with the Act, rates in negotiated agreements must be just and reasonable, nondiscriminatory, and based on the cost of providing the interconnection or network element. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). In reviewing agreements or portions thereof, the Commission, generally, is guided by 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2), requiring that interconnection agreements not discriminate against non-parties and be consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
- 6. We find it consistent with the terms of the agreement, the directives of the Act, and the spirit of our own interconnection agreement rules to approve the Report of Adoption subject to our own rules and general rate-making proceedings.

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II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The joint filing of a Report of Adoption by Qwest Corporation and New Age Electronics, Inc., to adopt Qwest Corporation's Ninth Revised Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions for Interconnection, Unbundled Network Elements, Ancillary Services, and Resale of Telecommunications Services is granted.
