I. **BY THE COMMISSION:**

> Α. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

On June 24, 2003, The City of Cripple Creek, filed an application seeking 1.

authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN)

PUC No. 55266.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 30, 2003. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on September 4, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the

requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 55266 is in the public interest.

II. **ORDER**

A. **The Commission Orders That:**

- 1. The hearing set for September 4, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on August 8, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by The City of Cripple Creek for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55266 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55266 is authorized from June 19, 2003 through December 19, 2003.
- 5. On or before November 19, 2003, the City of Cripple Creek shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55266 or to extend the suspension period.
- 6. Prior to reinstatement, the City of Cripple Creek shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. The City of Cripple Creek shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
- 7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55266 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

- 8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
