I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On May 30, 2003, Sweet Pea Tours, LLC, filed an application seeking authority to

suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No.

48202S.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 16, 2003. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on August 20, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is non-contested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with application warrants the grant of the requested

suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 48202S is in the public interest.

II. **ORDER**

- A. **The Commission Orders That:**
- 1. The hearing set for August 20, 2003, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on August 21, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Sweet Pea Tours, LLC for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 48202S is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 48202S is authorized from June 1, 2003 through October 1, 2003.
- 5. On or before September 10, 2003, Sweet Pea Tours, LLC shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 48202S or to extend the suspension period.
- Prior to reinstatement, Sweet Pea Tours, LLC shall cause to be filed with the 6. Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Sweet Pea Tours, LLC shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
- 7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 48202S or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

- 8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
