SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On July 24, 2003, Cypress Hospitality, LLC doing business as Radisson Hotel Denver Stapleton Plaza, filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9840.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on July 28, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on September 30, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is non-contested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants the grant of the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend Permit No. B-9840 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for September 30, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on September 11, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Cypress Hospitality, LLC doing business as Radisson Hotel Denver Stapleton Plaza, for authority to suspend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9840 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9840 is authorized from August 4, 2003, through February 4, 2004.
5. On or before January 6, 2004, Cypress Hospitality, LLC doing business as Radisson Hotel Denver Stapleton Plaza, shall file a written request either to reinstate Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9840 or to extend the suspension period.
6. Prior to reinstatement, Cypress Hospitality, LLC doing business as Radisson Hotel Denver Stapleton Plaza, shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Cypress Hospitality, LLC doing business as Radisson Hotel Denver Stapleton Plaza shall also file a proper tariff and pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.

7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9840 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the permit without further notice.

8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
