SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On July 22, 2003, Vail Valley Transportation, Inc. filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), PUC No. 9745, from July 22, 2003, through January 22, 2004.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on July 28, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on September 30, 2003.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is non-contested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with the application warrants the grant of the requested suspension.

5. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 9745 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

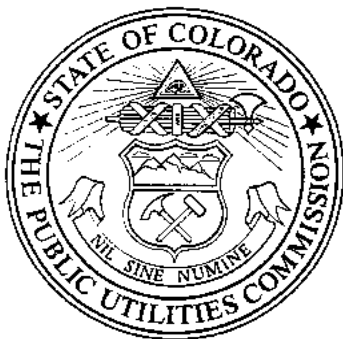
A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for September 30, 2003, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on September 17, 2003, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The application filed by Vail Valley Transportation, Inc., for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9745 is granted.
4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9745 is authorized from July 22, 2003, through January 22, 2004.
5. On or before January 2, 2004, Vail Valley Transportation, Inc., shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9745 or to extend the suspension period.
6. Prior to reinstatement, Vail Valley Transportation, Inc., shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Vail Valley Transportation, Inc., shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.
7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9745 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.

8. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
